

### Great Wall Auto entered into China top eight motor sellers in Dec

BEIJING (Asian Metal) 20 Jan 12 – According to China Automobile Industry Association, Chinese motor production and sales in 2011 both reached 18 millions, but only up by 0.84% and 2.45% respectively which went down the lowest levels of the past 13 years. Chinese motor production and sales kept stable in December 2011 month-on-month.

Chinese top eight motor sellers kept the same in October and November, but Great Wall Auto entered into the top eight and Huachen Auto fell down out of the top ten.

The flowing table shows sales of Chinese top eight motor sellers in December and their MOM changes (Unit: 10,000).

The total motor sales of the above eight plants reached 1.36 million, which took up about 80% of the total sales in December.
